Saving Goal :

Materials Needed

- Clean, empty jars or plastic containers
- · Stickers, markers, and colored paper
- Glue, tape, and scissors
- Optional: glitter, washi tape, or fabric for decoration





Instructions:

Your Savings Jar will be your personal "Savings Jar" where you can save coins or bills toward a specific goal. Think about something you want to save for in the new year (a toy, book, or special outing).

- Decorate the Jar: Get creative with decorations that match your saving goal. For example, if you're saving for a new bike, you can draw or paste bike-themed images on the jar.
- · Label It: Use a piece of paper or sticker to write the goal on

the jar. For example: "Saving for a New Game!"

- Add Progress Markers: Add lines or stickers to the jar as progress markers, showing how close you are to reaching their goal.
- Kick Off Savings: Work with an adult to see if they would give
 you some money to start your savings journey. Or ask if there
 are any jobs around the house that you can help with to earn
 some money for your savings goal.
